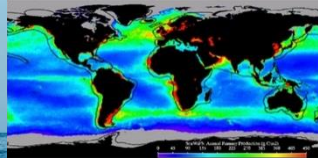


# Summer Immersive Course: Ecology of Marine and Estuarine Birds
