

# MARBLED MURRELET BIBLIOGRAPHY

This bibliography is a compilation of references on Marbled Murrelets (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*). The first draft of this compilation was derived from citations contributed by G. Alcorn, H. R. Carter, R. H. Day, D. B. Marshall, S. K. Nelson, C. J. Ralph, S. G. Sealy, S. M. Speich, and D. Varoujean. Over the past two decades, certain contributors (i.e., Sealy, Carter, Day) have conducted exhaustive literature searches to summarize known aspects of murrelet biology throughout its range whereas other contributors have provided additional local and historical references. The bibliography was circulated several times to members of the Marbled Murrelet Technical Group of the Pacific Seabird Group for additions and corrections. We think that this bibliography is complete for almost all published and most unpublished works that contain information about Marbled Murrelets, through January 1992. It was not possible to include all published and unpublished works that mention Marbled Murrelets, especially local, regional, state, and larger area checklists; non-English publications; field guides; faunal lists; avian atlases; popular articles; general avian biology works; observations reported in *Bird Lore*, *Audubon Field Notes*, and *American Birds*; difficult-to-access unpublished reports; abstracts; and many accounts in local newspapers, newsletters, and bulletins. Only representative references that deal with anatomy, morphology, taxonomy, and phylogeny are included. To locate and provide citations for all of these other sources would require an inordinate amount of effort over several years (e.g. see Campbell et al. [1979, 1988]). Individual researchers should investigate sources not included in this bibliography for additional information that may be pertinent for their purposes.
