Assemblyman Farr:

The Pacific Seabird Group (PSG) is a non-profit scientific organization dedicated to the research and conservation of the marine birds of the Pacific. Protection of marine resources is one of the most important activities in the conservation of seabirds. Assembly Bill No. 3804 would benefit seabirds and other marine life by the establishment of Marine Resource Zones. PSG supports Bill No. 3804.

However, the Bill is incomplete without sufficient funding to establish the program. The program as described in the Bill should only be initiated if the appropriate state agencies are provided with the funds and employees necessary to select the areas. The program parallels the Ecological Reserve System. The appropriate state agencies will need time and money to review existing state and federal programs in order to select the correct areas and avoid duplication.
